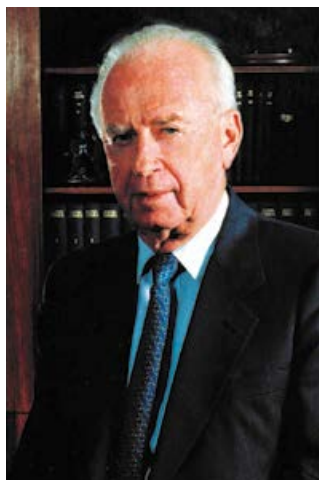

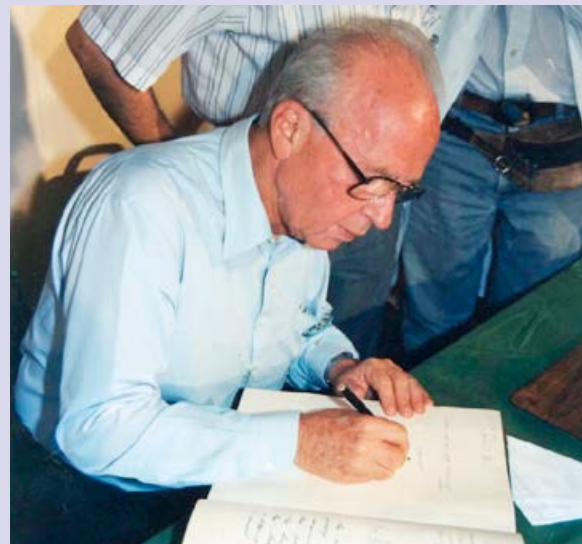

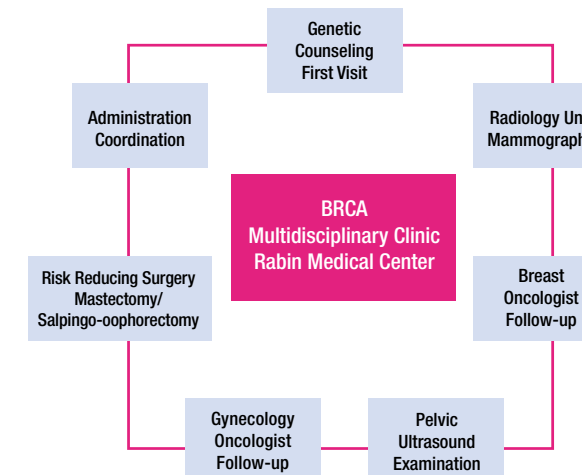

Established in 2011 by AFRMC, The Rabin Medical Fellowship Exchange brings Rabin doctors and researchers to study in illustrious hospitals across the United States. AFRMC seeks funding for Fellowships in two tiers: \$6,500–\$10,000 for periods ranging from two weeks to six months; and \$25,000–\$40,000 for extensive year-long residencies. Rabin Fellows gain invaluable medical expertise as they observe and research in their practice to benefit their work at Rabin Medical Center. THE INNOVATION LAB AT RABIN MEDICAL CENTER

WHERE ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE MEETS MEDICINE

Our mission is to lead in the detection, research, development and implementation of urgent clinical needs

- The Innovation Center includes the "Innovation Incubator" that promotes inventions for particular needs, based on the bio-design method from Stanford BioDesign, as well as a center for artificial intelligence, big data, design, and 3D printing.
- Medical insights combined with internal research and development capabilities are leveraged by external entrepreneurs. One of the unique features of the Innovation Center is that research and development happens inside the hospitals.
- Dr. Leor Perl, head cardiac interventionist and chief innovation officer at Rabin Medical Center directs the Innovation Center, which is a group of professionals from different complementary backgrounds, ranging from business executives to senior physicians of all medical fields. Upon identification and research of a new unmet need, the center form specialized groups who are able to rapidly iterate, research and test new technological solutions within the hospital.

RABIN MEDICAL CENTER ON THE FRONT LINE

RABIN OPENS HOSPITAL ANNEX IN EILAT, SOUTHERN ISRAEL TO TREAT CASUALTIES

Israel has evacuated over 70,000 civilians from the northern and southern borders because of missile attacks. Eilat, a city with 50,000 inhabitants in the south of the country, is now housing all these displaced Israelis.

In response to this emergency, Rabin Medical Center opened an **Emergency Hospital Annex in Eilat** to provide medical services to this overstretched population of displaced Israelis who have been forced out of their homes, lost their loved ones, and experienced horrendous crimes against humanity at the onslaught of the horrific massacre that occurred in villages and towns adjacent to the Gaza border. This annex—over 217 miles away from

Rabin Medical Center in Greater Tel Aviv—is an extension of the hospital and provides medical services to this suffering and displaced population.



RABIN MEDICAL CENTER OPENS EMERGENCY UNDERGROUND HOSPITAL DURING ESCALATION OF WAR

Thousands of casualties from the south and across the country are streaming into Rabin Medical Center, located in Greater Tel Aviv. The hospital manages the influx of wounded and maimed by re-opening its 3,100 square foot underground emergency hospital. Originally built during the COVID-19 pandemic, the converted underground car park spans two floors and is fully protected from any above ground attacks. Rabin Medical Center's above ground 5,400 square foot Emergency & Trauma

Center, with over 100 stations, is a fortified space; however it cannot sustain long term missile attacks. This underground emergency ward has the capacity to hold hundreds of beds and also includes an intensive care ward, two internal wards, and a 20-station dialysis unit.

Dr. Eytan Wirtheim, CEO of Rabin Medical Center. "Our highest priority is to treat our patients and unfortunately, past experience has shown us that during war, there is a need to have a fortified hospital so that we can continue treating patients during a rocket attack or even a chemical attack. Our staff is trained for these types of scenarios and how to continue patient care during times like these. Because of their extensive training for a situation like this, they jump right into action."

Israeli President Isaac Herzog visited the hospital to meet with recovering victims of the war and said, "We are here in the protected underground hospital, opened especially for this war. It is truly amazing and impressive, and I encourage the public to appreciate the value and contribution of Rabin Medical Center."



RABIN'S EMERGENCY MEDICAL STAFF DURING WARTIME: WE MUST PREVAIL

Dr. Felix Benninger, Deputy Director, Department of Neurology: "We moved many hospital wards to our underground facility. It looks very scary there, but it fits the situation. The top floors of the hospital are



completely empty due to the threat of daily rocket attacks. Just now here in Tel Aviv we had two attacks where we had to seek shelter. We need all the support and help we can get. I have to tell you that our American Friends of Rabin Medical Center are a huge pillar here... There was a movement of help which is still echoing for everybody—so really, thank you very

much. We need your help also in the coming weeks and days. It will be very difficult—it will probably be more difficult than it is."

Dr. Yona Kosashvili, Head of the Orthopedic Department: "The Orthopedic Department in Rabin Medical Center takes care of most of the casualties, and I am very proud of my team both on the surgical ground and the team spirit. Hopefully this will be over soon. We have to prevail. Failure is not an option."

Because of its central location in Greater Tel Aviv, Rabin Medical Center is a leading hospital in Israel treating the mounting war casualties, released hostages and trauma victims from all across the country.



AFRMC FUNDS EMERGENCY MEDICAL NURSING STAFF



- **ICU TRAINING:** Education and training of nurses and physicians from other medical departments to treat incoming wounded soldiers and civilians in the ER/ICU.

- **PSYCHOLOGICAL, TRAUMA & COUNSELING SUPPORT:** Individual/group sessions with social workers, psychologists and mental health professionals to cope with intense stress and trauma.

- **TRAUMA & CRISIS HOSTAGE SUPPORT:** Critical training for health professionals, social workers and psychologists working with released hostages, including children and young adults. This support takes months, even years, to fully aid victims in their recovery.

INNOVATIVE MEDICAL RESEARCH AT RABIN MEDICAL CENTER

Dr. Yaron Barac was appointed Head of the Chest Transplantation Unit at Rabin, following his three-year AFRMC fellowship at Duke University Hospital.

Dr. Yael Graif conducted a study that linked asthma and migraines, suggesting that the two are significantly correlated.

Dr. Reut Tomashov-Matar co-developed a new blood test to diagnose genetic disorders in fetuses early in pregnancy by sequencing small amounts of DNA in the mother's and father's blood.

Dr. Omer Zarchi guided a breakthrough technology that maps the cerebral cortex during brain surgery. It won first prize at the Technion Faculty of Biomedical Engineering project fair.

Rabin Medical Center researchers collaborated with Microsoft Israel, using big data to predict and prevent falls in the elderly.

Dr. Igor Snast discovered that 78% of all psoriasis is directly derived from stressful life events and occurrences.

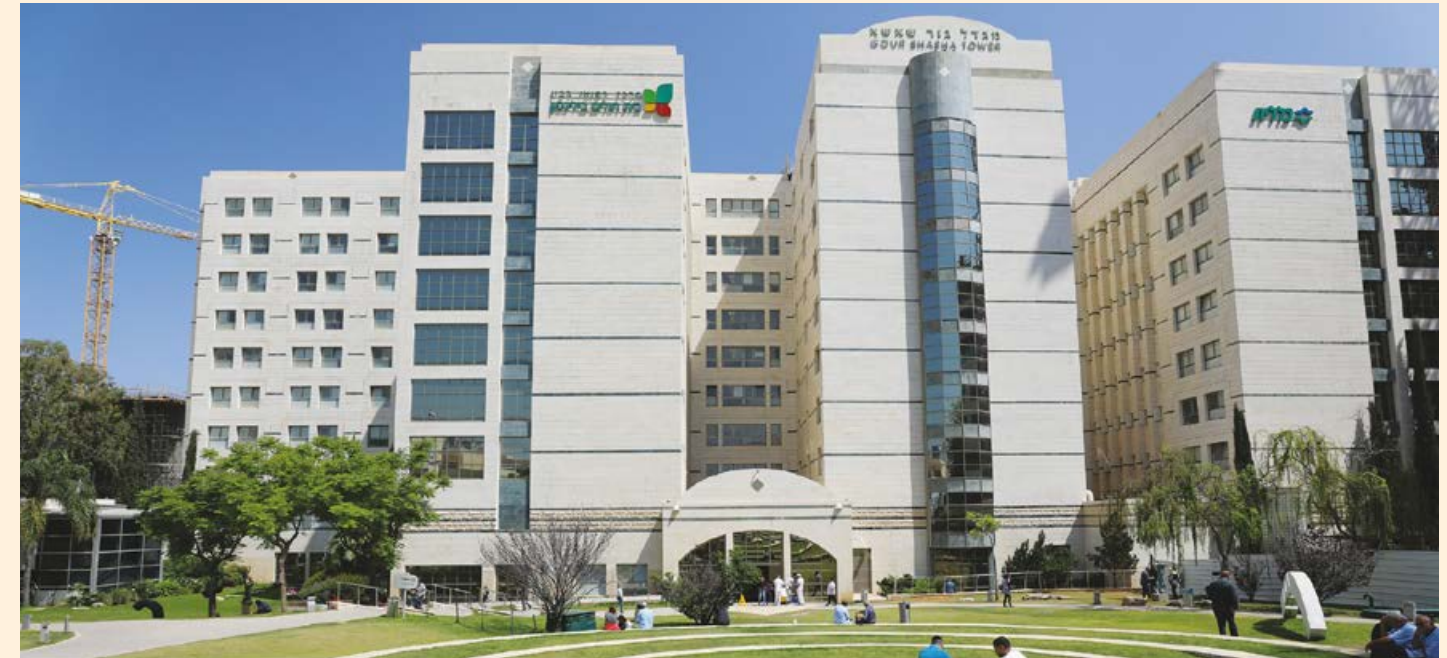
Dr. Dror Dicker's pilot trial of a drug-free, soft silicone nasal insert helped patients achieve weight loss goals.

Dr. Hadas Steiner's sponsored delegation to Tanzania instructed local teams in emergency medicine.

Dr. Irit Bahar conducted clinical trials of synthetic corneal implants to correct corneal blindness.

Dr. Lior Perl inaugurated the Innovation Incubator Lab at Rabin Medical Center, which allows for the intersection of entrepreneurship and medical innovation.

Doctors at Rabin's Division of Cardiovascular and Thoracic Surgery developed the first Cardiac Accessory Implant Surgery in Israel.

RABIN MEDICAL CENTER WORLDWIDE HUMANITARIAN MEDICAL CARE



UKRAINE: Rabin Medical Center has always been committed to humanitarian activities and believes deeply in providing medical aid to those in need. At the very onset of the war in Ukraine, Rabin Medical Center took immediate action and, along with the Jewish Agency, provided essential medical aid as well as a delegation of its own medical nurses and staff to join task forces in refugee camps across Eastern Europe.

TURKEY: When the earthquake struck sections of Turkey and Syria in February 2023, it was Israel, the smallest country in the region, that jumped in to offer not just condolences, but also state-of-the-art rescue capabilities. Within hours of the first quake, Rabin Medical Center's delegation arrived with field medical personnel and assets to help its neighbors.

CENTERS OF MEDICAL EXCELLENCE JUSIDMAN EMERGENCY & TRAUMA CENTER

Emergency and Trauma—Where Every Second Counts

Each year, Rabin Medical Center's emergency rooms admit and treat over 200,000 patients. Designated as a Level 1 Trauma Center (funded by AFRMC), one of only six in Israel, it provides superior emergency care for major trauma victims—saving the lives of civilians and soldiers, adults and children. Rabin's heliport and vital services stand ready for all types of emergencies, while the hospital continually prepares itself against conventional, chemical, biological and all-out warfare. The 54,000 square foot Emergency & Trauma Center includes a Triage and Admittance section; a Fast-Track Clinic; imaging facilities and advanced diagnostic and life-saving equipment to cope with large scale disasters. Rabin Medical Center is a global leader in developing the capacity to safely assess, decontaminate, and treat victims of terrorist attacks and other disasters.



EMERGENCY CARE IN THE ORTHOPEDICS DEPARTMENT

WARTIME MESSAGE FROM RABIN MEDICAL CENTER'S HEAD OF THE ORTHOPEDIC DEPARTMENT



While treating the countless casualties from the Hamas missile attacks, the Head of the Orthopedic Department posted this on Social Media: "I am Professor **Yona Kosashvili**, a retired major, former military doctor, treating the injured, together with my wonderful orthopedic team here at Rabin Medical Center. Here we see all of the Israeli people, both in the injured, and in the staff treating them. Our hearts are with our fighters at the fronts, I know that each of our injured was treated at the front, and they were defended by their commanders who gave them their hearts and souls. Our hearts are with them, and we will give them everything they need, I wish them good health. And we shall prevail."

SEVERE BURN VICTIMS RECEIVE INNOVATIVE TREATMENT

Soldiers, civilians and hostages are receiving a pioneering new treatment for burns that is saving limbs and speeding up recovery time. The Israeli-based company MediWound created NexoBrid, an enzyme-based product which is a topically applied product that treats scarred tissue without harming the surrounding healthy tissue.

NexoBrid's quick removal of damaged tissue reduces the risk of infection, sepsis and potential scarring. It's topical application also minimizes invasive surgical procedures.

The product allows medical staff to replace standard sur-

gery practices with enzymatic surgery, allowing them to remove dead tissue within the wound or severe burn. The product is considered a game changer in a more effective, less invasive treatment to burns and wounds.

Physicians state that enzymatic surgery reduces the number of skin grafts and surgeries, as well as reducing patient suffering and lengthy hospitalization.

The five major burn centers in Israel have purchased this product, and are looking to acquire emergency stockpiles of the product in anticipation of future war casualties.

CENTER OF MEDICAL EXCELLENCE RECANATI GENETICS INSTITUTE

The Genetics Institute's research activities focus on investigating the molecular and pathophysiological basis of rare syndromes through identifying and studying new genes and generating potential therapeutic protocols, medication treatments and gene therapies.



- **PRENATAL GENETICS COUNSELING:** In Israel many tests are carried out during pregnancy to evaluate and assess the fetus, including screening blood to evaluate for chromosomal aberrations and ultrasounds to detect congenital birth defects.
- **ONCOGENETICS:** This is a new field of genetics dealing with family genetic predisposition to cancer, where oncogenetics counselors assess individuals and families with genetic predisposition to cancer. Thousands of patients are evaluated annually.
- **OLECULAR GENETICS:** New tests being introduced include the Duschene Muscular Dystrophy testing, TPMT (a new test used to assess a patient's ability to tolerate specific chemotherapy treatment) and testing for the genetic component in colorectal cancer.



- **PEDIATRIC & ADULT GENETICS CLINIC:** This clinic offers counseling and evaluation of children and adults with birth defects, suspected or diagnosed genetic syndromes, chromosomal syndromes, metabolic disorders, developmental delay and a family history of genetic conditions.
- **MEDITERRANEAN FEVER CLINIC:** This clinic, the largest and best of its kind in Israel and internationally, identifies the causative gene for this common genetic disease in Israel and other Mediterranean countries.
- **GAUCHER CENTER:** This center of excellence within the Genetics Institute evaluates and treats Gaucher, a prevalent disease in the Ashkenazi Jewish population. These patients benefit from enzyme replacement, therapy infusions and new oral approaches.

CENTER OF MEDICAL EXCELLENCE DAVIDOFF COMPREHESIVE CANCER CENTER

Rabin's Davidoff Cancer Center, opened in 2005, is the leading oncology facility in Israel and the Middle East. To date, over 150,000 patients have received treatment at the center, which provides the most innovative and technologically advanced care for various types of cancer. Funded through the vision and generosity of the Davidoff Family, the center sponsors exchange fellowships for its doctors while hosting renowned cancer experts from major hospitals across the globe.

Rabin Medical Center also established the Davidoff Center's International Board, a group of cancer experts from leading institutions around the world that regularly meets in Israel to share their research and discoveries. The Davidoff Center has become a global leader in cancer research and a place of healing for Israelis and patients from throughout the region and world. The expansion of the center was completed in 2022.

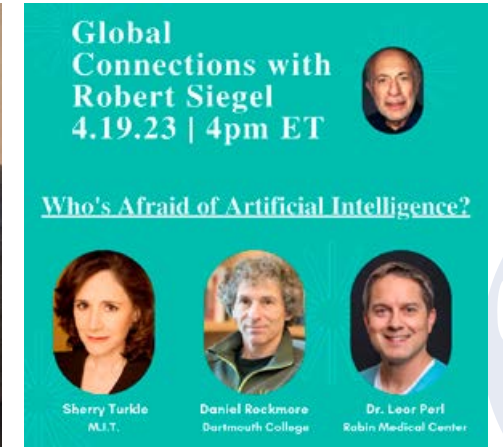
